



MASTERS LEVEL INTERNSHIP ADOLESCENT DAY TREATMENT



Join a dynamic, multidisciplinary team as a master's level practicum student at Anicca, Carver County's Adolescent Day Treatment Program, serving children and families ages 13-17.

Two sites, both located in Chanhassen, provide intensive therapeutic intervention and educational programming for teens that need a structured, supportive treatment setting to work through mental health issues.

Receive comprehensive training in group, individual, and family treatment in a supportive community environment that provides a foundation for licensing standards and future clinical work with adolescents and families.

Learning Opportunities

- Group Therapy and milieu development
- Individual and Family Therapy
- Diagnostic Assessment and Treatment Planning
- Clinical Documentation
- Develop and deliver psychoeducational and skills groups to support coping and pro-social skills
- Teaming, co-therapy, and case consultation built into the daily process of the program
- Weekly individual supervision with a Licensed Mental Health Professional

Requirements

- Practicum student status in a master's degree program of a college or University in the following disciplines:
 - Marriage and Family Therapy
 - Counseling Psychology
 - Social Work
- 3 days per week minimum
- 9- or 12-month commitment depending on degree requirements and openings
- Monday – Friday schedule; 7:30-3:30 (with typical holiday and school breaks)
- Internships typically begin May/June or August/September. Other placement start dates may be considered.
